OPPORTUNITY DRAWING tickets will be sold at 10 for \$10.

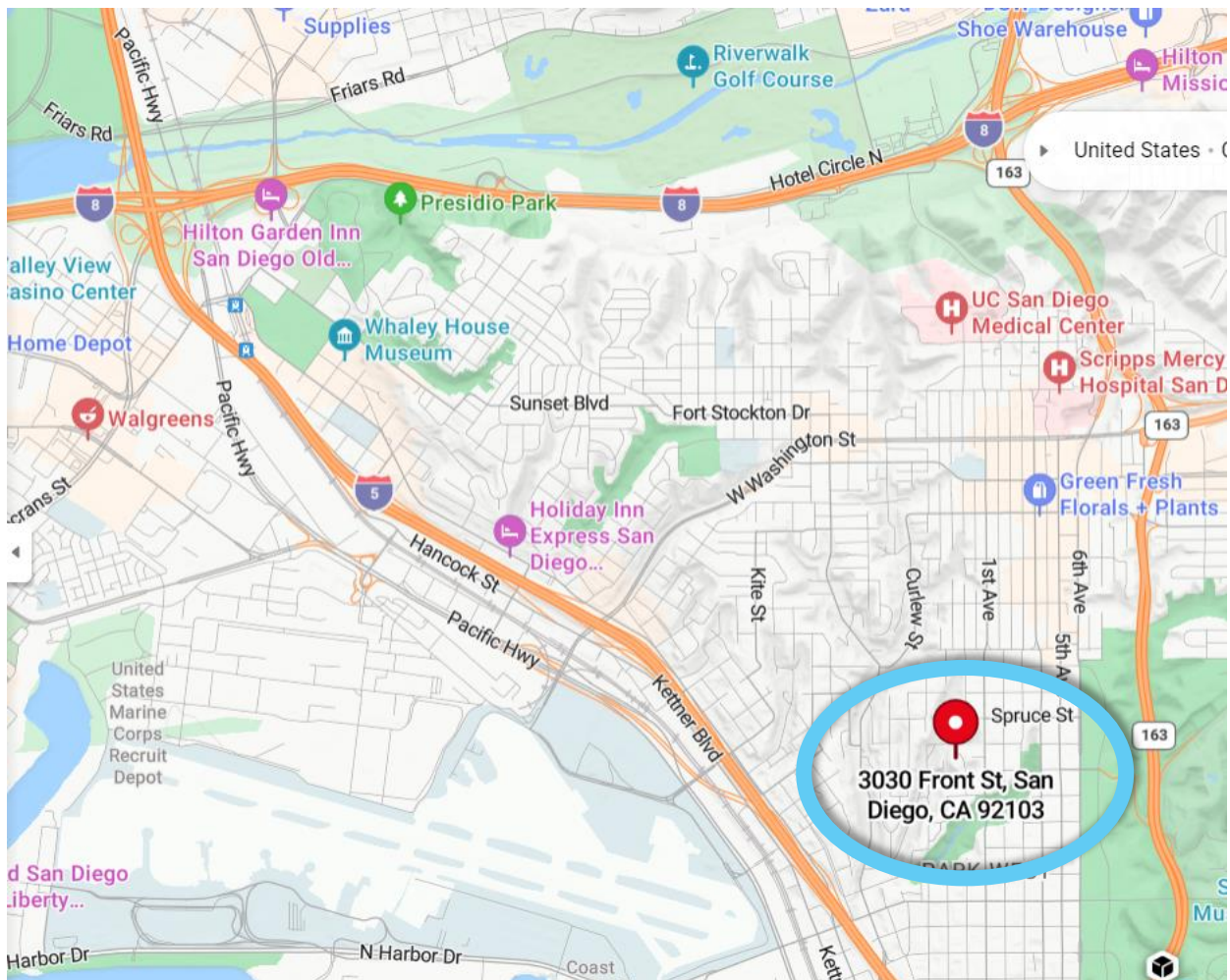
